

On November 28, we lost a long-time faithful member of the Puget Sound Olds Club. Art Gamash lived to the age of 96. Art was born in Nashua, New Hampshire on April 14, 1921. He passed peacefully with his family by his side on November 28, 2017.

During World War II, Art served in the U.S. Army Corps as an instrument repairman on B-17, B-24, and P-51 Mustang aircraft. After the war he graduated from the University of New Hampshire in 1955 with a Bachelor's Degree in Mechanical Engineering.

Art met his wife Trudy, a Registered Nurse, on a blind date where they both watched TV for the first time. In later years, when people would ask him for the secret of his longevity he would say, "I married a nurse!"

Art worked for 5 years with IBM in New York then moved to Seattle and worked for Boeing until his retirement. While at Boeing, his projects included the B-1 Bomber, ground support for the Apollo Moon program and the AWACS.

Time spent with family was cherished, whether it was camping trips and ball games with his sons, Nutcracker ballet with his daughter, playing cars with his grand-daughters or Angry Birds with his great-grandchildren.

Art was preceded in death by his mother Alice, his father Arthur, his sisters Grace and Lois, and his wife Trudy. He is survived by his three sons, his daughter, four grandchildren and 2 great grandchildren.

Most of us in the Puget Sound Olds Club remember Art for his faithful attendance at chapter events. Pam and I had the privilege of representing the chapter at Art's service on Dec.11 in Sequim at St. Joseph Catholic Church.


