

One day while entering the garage for a garden tool or some other "non-car" task, I heard a very faint buzzing sound. As I walked around the garage, I could tell that when I was close to the '63 Olds the sound appeared to be a bit stronger. Lifting the cover, the sound got a slight bit louder. 


