(This story by Jeff Koch of *Hemmings Daily* is so funny that I could not resist sharing it.)



# To all attendees of the 2018 Greenwood Car Show:

The following are the arrival and locating instructions for **June 30, 2018**.

- 1. We will be between N 81<sup>st</sup> and N 82<sup>nd</sup> on the EAST side of Greenwood Ave N., occupying up to 7 spots (more if needed) for the Oldsmobile Club.
- Arrival time: Opens at 5:30 AM and you <u>MUST</u> be in place <u>NLT 7:30 AM</u>.
- 3. From I-5 North bound, take the N 85<sup>th</sup> exit and proceed west bound to Aurora Ave N. Turn LEFT to N 80<sup>th</sup>. Turn Right on N 80<sup>th</sup> St. Drive West bound on N 80<sup>th</sup> St. Turn RIGHT, at Dayton Ave N then LEFT at N 81<sup>st</sup> St. At the top of the hill is Greenwood Ave N. There may be a barricade at the top of the hill. Just move it and turn RIGHT.
- 4. From I-5 South bound, take the N 80<sup>th</sup> exit and proceed West bound thru Aurora Ave N. Drive West bound on N 80<sup>th</sup> St. Turn RIGHT, at Dayton Ave N then LEFT at N 81<sup>st</sup> St. At the top of the hill is Greenwood Ave N. There may be a barricade at the top of the hill. Just move it and turn RIGHT.
- 5. There will be a Show Attendant (probably myself) to direct you to park in the proper location.


