

1971 W30 4-Speed Convertible - One of 32 built

The Barrett-Jackson auction in Palm Beach, Florida two weeks ago featured a large number of Oldsmobile convertibles crossing the block. Many of the convertibles sold for over \$100,000. The '71 W30 pictured above sold for \$131,000, including buyer's premium.

Among the other Olds convertibles selling for over \$100k were a Yellow '72 442 for \$139,700, a'69 442 for \$137,500, a '66 442 Custom for \$117,700, a '71 442 Triple Black for \$110,000, a '69 442 Triple Black for \$137,500 and a '53 98 for \$110,000.

Convertibles not reaching the \$100k mark were a '72 442 for \$99,000, a '56 Starfire for \$84,700, a '60 98 for \$84,700, a '55 98 Starfire for \$66,000, a '49 98 with a see thru hood for \$57,200, a '52 Super 88 for \$52,800 and a '69 442 for \$46,700. 

Arrive at 2509 196th St SW on the left


From I-5 North of Lynwood
